Qualified individuals must have strong strategic thinking skills, excellent verbal and written communication skills in English and one (or more) of the following languages: Bengali, Gujarati, Hindi, Urdu, or other South Asian language, strong interpersonal skills, commitment to advancing health and racial equity, comfort using technology, and a willingness to learn.

Community Organizers will occasionally work long and/or irregular hours, including evenings and weekends. APDC provides health, dental, vacation, paid sick day, matching retirement, and free EcoPass benefits.
